



Talk on the Apology Ordinance (Cap. 631)

Content

The Apology Ordinance was enacted in July 2017 and came into operation on 1 December 2017. The objective of the Apology Ordinance is to promote and encourage the making of apologies with a view to preventing the escalation of disputes and facilitating their amicable resolution. The presentation will cover the reasons for enacting apology legislation, the contents of the Apology Ordinance and the legal implications of offering an apology after commencement of the ordinance.

Miss Chen was admitted as a solicitor in Hong Kong. She joined the Department of Justice of Hong Kong after practising in private practice for about 2 years. She has worked in the Commercial Unit of the Department of Justice for more than 20 years and has advised on a broad range of major commercial initiatives of the Government, including the demutualization and merger of the Stock Exchange, Futures Exchange and Clearing Houses of Hong Kong, and partial privatization of MTRCL in 2000, the

first issue of Government Bonds and Notes in 2004, rewrite of the Companies Ordinance, and the enactment of the Competition Ordinance in 2011.

In September 2016, the Department of Justice established a Joint Dispute Resolution Strategy Office (JDRSO) to enhance the overall coordination of arbitration and mediation work of the Department. Miss Chen was appointed the first Commissioner of the JDRSO to act as the single point of contact on all matters related to the promotion of dispute resolution of Hong Kong. She assisted in the enactment of the Apology Ordinance and the Arbitration and Mediation Legislation (Third Party Funding) (Amendment) Ordinance respectively in June and July this year.
